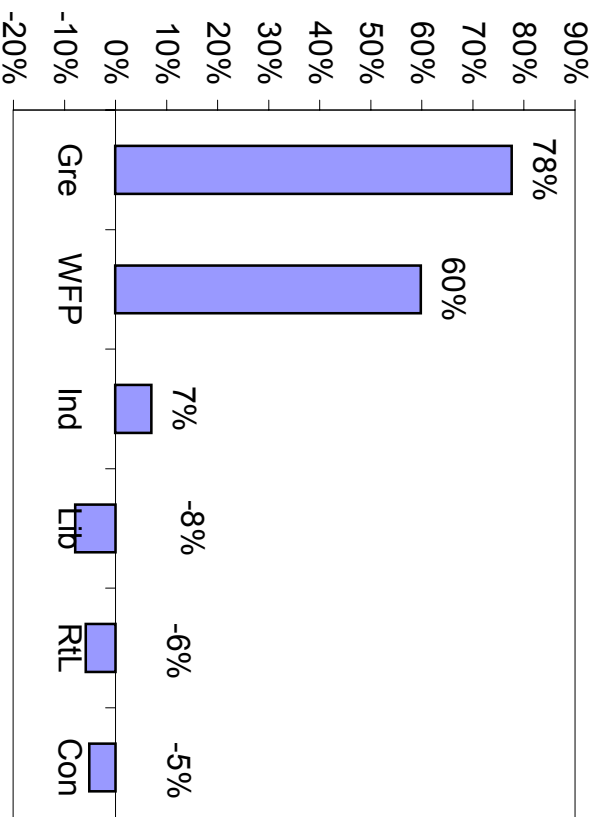

## Minor Party Registration %Change from Nov '00 to Nov '01



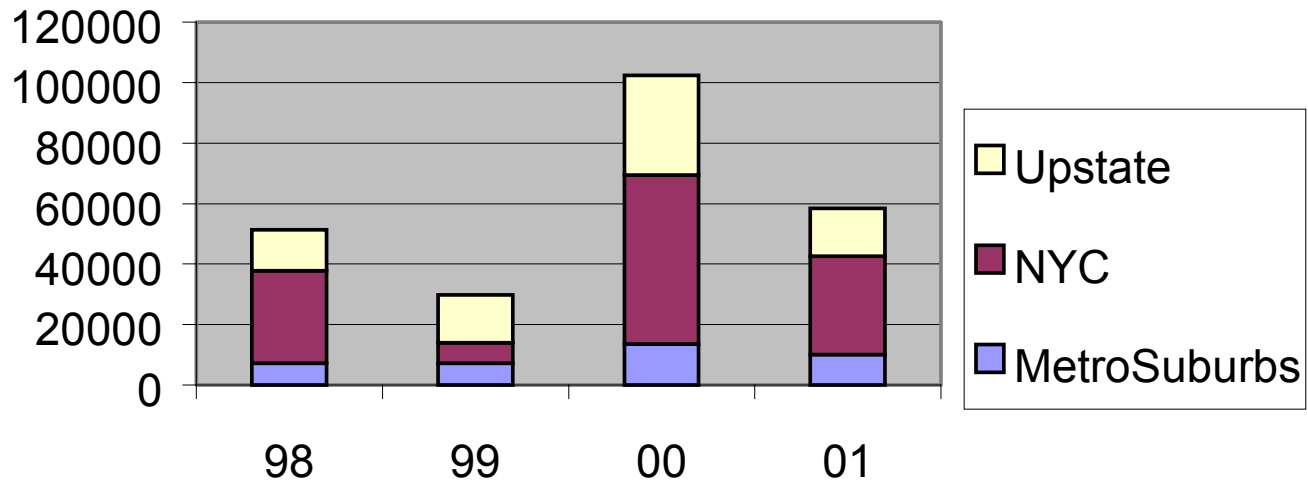

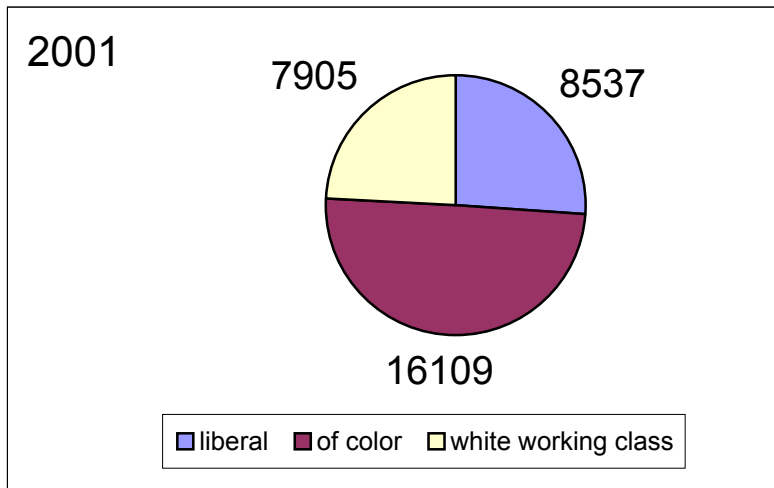
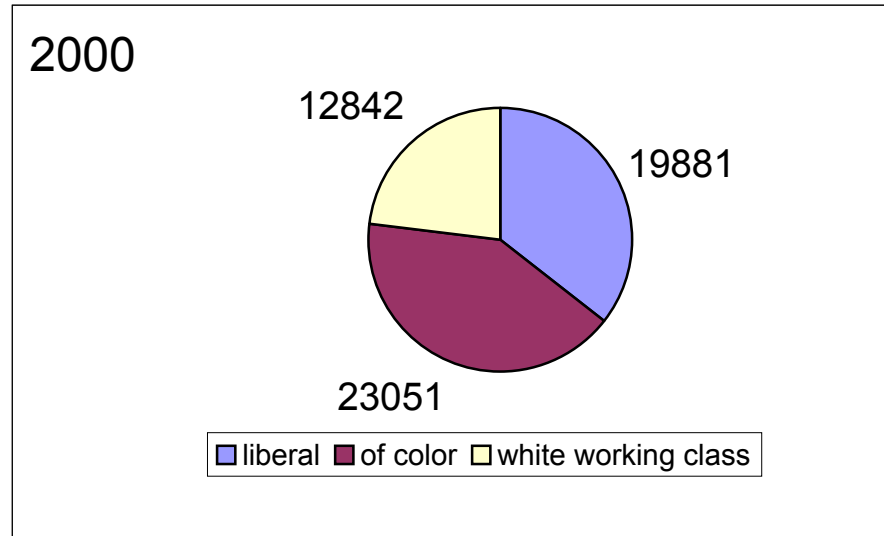
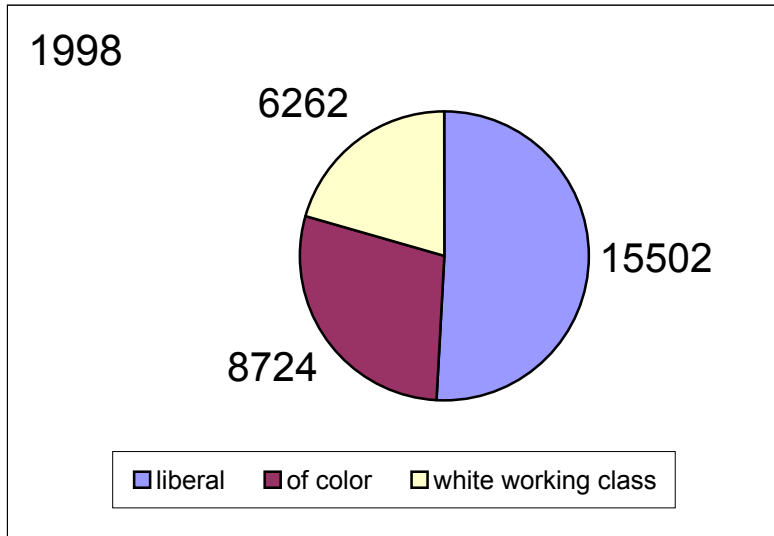
